Improving the Pricing System in the Road Sector: Highlighting and Addressing Relevant Issues

- Transformation of the pricing system in construction industry, including highway engineering, which seemed quite distant in mid-2016, is now gradually gathering momentum, becoming more and more real for Russian construction specialists. Over the past year, a large number of cost estimates have been approved, and a new budget and regulatory framework for 2017 has come into effect. Preliminary results
- State information pricing system in construction industry, including subsystems for the survey of construction resources prices, maintenance of the federal register of cost estimates, and for construction resources classifier, viewed as a step towards the transition to a resource method for determining construction costs.
